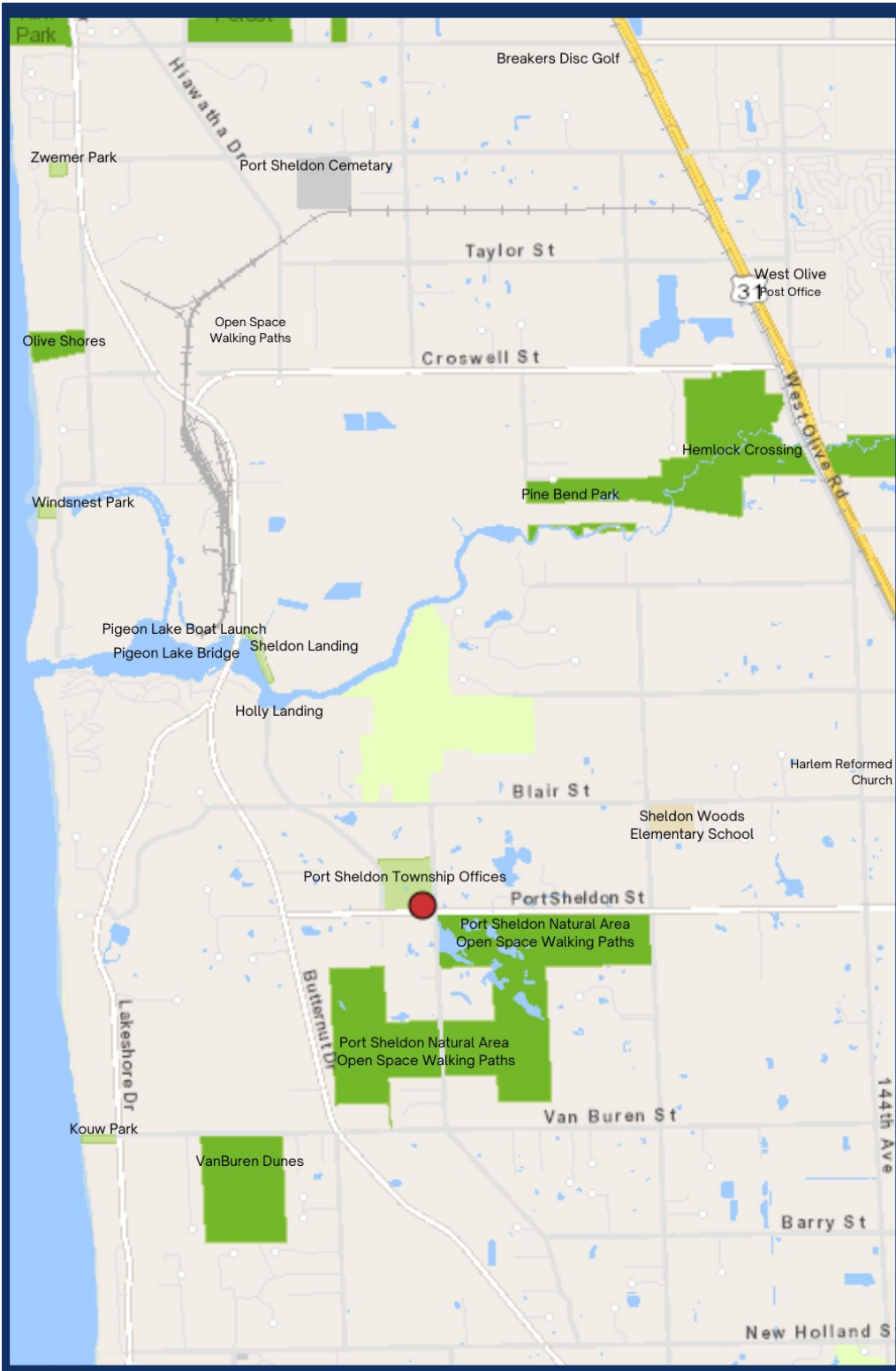

- **Port Sheldon Natural Area**
 - What is the name of the creek?
- **Hemlock Crossing**
 - What types of activities are encouraged at this park?
 - Find the bench on trail 9, what is the quote?
- **Van Buren Street Dunes**
 - What color are the trail arrows?
 - What is the distance in miles of the entire length of trails?

- **Township Offices, Courts & Playground**
